To Parent/Guardian:

In accordance with the Child Care and Early Years Act, 2014 sections 35 and 72; licensed childcare centres in Durham Region must provide enrolment and immunization information to Durham Region Health Department for assessment.

Childcare centres must ensure that any child in attendance is immunized against diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus, polio, varicella, meningococcal conjugate C, measles, mumps, and rubella, as required by the local Medical Officer of Health. Exemptions may be granted for medical reason, or for reasons of conscience or religious belief.

Immunization Requirements of Children Attending Childcare in Durham Region



CHECKLIST FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Your childcare centre relies on you to provide up to date immunization documents for your child. Please check below to ensure you have provided required documents to the childcare centre prior to admission as required under the Child Care and Early Years Act.

Have you attached a copy of your child's immunization history? The childcare centre requires your child's immunization history before they attend childcare. They will send a copy to Durham Region Health Department for assessment. Parents that cannot immunize their child for medical reasons must provide a ministry-issued Statement of Medical Exemption form completed by their healthcare provider. Parents that choose not to immunize their child for philosophical reasons must provide a ministry-issued

Statement of Conscience or Religious Belief affidavit completed by a commissioner of oaths.

When you photocopy the inside of your child's immunization record, please add your child's name and date of birth to the top of the photocopy.

Does this immunization record have all of your child's immunizations on it?

Please ensure all immunizations are reported to your childcare centre. If any immunizations are missing from your child's immunization record, please obtain an updated copy from your healthcare provider.

Stick to the Schedule!

It's important to follow Ontario's recommended immunization schedule to keep your child protected as early as possible. Some required immunizations may not be valid when they are given too early, or too close to one another. Ontario's immunization schedule is available Ontario.ca/page/vaccines & durham.ca/immunize

Your healthcare provider does not report immunizations to the Health Department.

Please remember to report every immunization your child receives to their childcare centre. The childcare centre will forward a copy to Durham Region Health Department for assessment.

ONTARIO'S ROUTINE IMMUNIZATION SCHEDULE



2 months of age (three immunizations due)

- Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, haemophilus influenzae type b (DTaP-IPV-Hib) vaccine
- Pneumococcal conjugate (Pneu-C-13) vaccine
- Rotavirus (Rot-1) vaccine

4 months of age (three immunizations due)

- Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, haemophilus influenzae type b (DTaP-IPV-Hib) vaccine
- Pneumococcal conjugate (Pneu-C-13) vaccine
- Rotavirus (Rot-1) vaccine

6 months of age (one immunization due)

• Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, haemophilus influenzae type b (DTaP-IPV-Hib) vaccine

12 months of age (three immunizations due)

- Measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) vaccine*
- Meningococcal conjugate (Men-C-C) vaccine*
- Pneumococcal conjugate (Pneu-C-13) vaccine

15 months of age (one immunization due)

Varicella (chickenpox) (Var) vaccine

18 months of age (one immunization due)

• Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, haemophilus influenzae type b (DTaP-IPV-Hib) vaccine

4 years of age (two immunizations due)

- Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis and polio (Tdap-IPV) vaccine*
- Measles, mumps, rubella and varicella (MMRV) vaccine

^{*}Doses of MMR vaccine and Men-C-C vaccine given prior to one year of age are not valid.

^{*}Doses of Tdap-IPV vaccine given prior to 4 years of age are not valid.
